Petitioner-Jaswinder Kumar has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.09 dated 15.05.2018, under Sections 7 and 13 (2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 and Section 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, District Jalandhar.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner was posted as Junior Engineer in P.S.P.C.L. As per the FIR, a raid was conducted and the present petitioner was apprehended red-handed while taking a bribe of ₹8,000/-.

The petitioner has been in custody since 18.05.2018 i.e. more than two months. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
