The instant writ petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to the official respondents to register an FIR under Sections 498-A, 406 of Indian Penal Code against the private respondents.

It is contended that no action has been taken against the culprits, despite the representation dated 29.05.2018 (Annexure P-1) moved to the SSP, Hoshiarpur . Learned counsel for the petitioner urges that the representation should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At this stage, on the asking of the court Ms. Rajni Gupta, Senior DAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that official respondents will look into the matter and will decide

the representation of the petitioner within a period of four weeks, on receipt of certified copy of this order. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to her during the course of the day, failing which no action is called for in the matter.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the representation dated 29.05.2018 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
