1. Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.0538 dated 12.10.2017, registered under Sections 323, 324, 34, 506 IPC (Section 326 added later on) at Police Station Sadar Thanesar, Kurukshetra.
2. As per allegations in the FIR, petitioner inflicted gandas blow on the elbow of left hand of the complainant. The said injury ultimately fell under the ambit of Section 326 IPC i.e. gandas blow on the left ulna of the complainant.
3. Recovery of weapon has already been effected.
4. The petitioner is in custody since 31.10.2017.
5. On 16.02.2018, learned State counsel submitted

before the Court that material witness i.e. the complainant would be examined on 21.02.2018. It appears that the witness has not been examined on the said date.

6. The injured has already been discharged from the hospital. The case is triable by the Magistrate.

7. Considering the aforesaid position, I deem it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on regular bail.

8. In view of above, petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

9. Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
