The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 17 dated 11.11.2017, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station NRI Hoshiarpur, Punjab.

According to the allegations made in the FIR, the petitioner identified Pritam Singh son of Jawala Singh as Malook Singh son of Jawala Singh whereas the said Malook Singh had already died in the year 1990. This was done to enable the said Pritam Singh to withdraw compensation of ₹ 1,31,863/- on account of acquisition of the land of Malook Singh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that one Gurmukh Singh son of Chanan Singh was also involved in the conspiracy and he has been granted interim anticipatory bail by this Court after directions were issued for deposit of ₹ 1,31,500/-. He submits that the amount stands already deposited.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Rajwinder Singh corroborates this statement.

In view of the above, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the

petitioner. The petition is allowed and petitioner – Nand Singh Lamberdar is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned at Hoshiarpur.
