Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to release the petitioners from protection home as now the petitioners want to go to their home because they do not apprehend danger from anyone.

Counsel for the petitioner states that vide order dated June 04, 2018 passed by this Court in **CRM-M-25103 of 2018** titled as ***Priya Rani and another Versus State of Haryana and others***, respondent No.2 Superintendent of Police, Panchkula was directed to look into the representation dated 01.06.2018 submitted by the petitioners and to take appropriate action in view of the threat perception to the petitioners. Since there was a threat perception to the petitioners, they were sent to the protection home, but now the petitioner do not apprehend any threat and wish

to leave the protection home for which they have already submitted a representation Annexure P-2 (undated) to the respondent No.2.

Notice of motion.

On asking of this Court, Mr. S.P.S. Tinna, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Without making any observation as regard threat perception, if any, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to take note of the contents of representation Annexure P-2 (undated) and to act in accordance with law.

It is made clear that in case the office of respondent No.2 has not received the representation Annexure P-2 (undated), the petitioners would be required to submit a fresh representation within one week from today on which the respondent No.2 shall look into the matter and shall act in accordance with law.
