The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.45 dated 04.06.2017, registered under Section 307/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act at Police Station Bhindi Saidan, District Amritsar on the basis of compromise.

After going through the FIR, this court is of the view that serious allegations have been levelled against the petitioner. Petitioner-Ranjit Singh has fired three shots with 12 bore riffle and pellets of those bullets hit the complainant in his chest, under the right eye and right side of the head.

It has been argued that now compromise has been effected and learned counsel for the complainant has also admitted this fact. But keeping in view the seriousness of injuries and nature of offence, this court is of the view that petitioner is required for custodial interrogation.

Petition stands dismissed accordingly.
