Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.87 dated 23.08.2017 under Sections 302/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Maqboolpura, District Amritsar.

Learned State Counsel submits that as against total 21 witnesses as cited by the prosecution, as many as 16 witnesses have already been examined and the remaining witnesses are mainly official witnesses and the case is now fixed for 24.09.2018.

In view of the advanced stage of trial which is likely to be culminated in the near future, the present petition is hereby dismissed.

However, the trial Court shall make an endeavour to expedite the trial and conclude the same preferably within three months from today, provided that no delay is being caused by the petitioner-accused.
