Petitioner-Ranvir Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.06 dated 03.10.2017, registered at Police Station State Vigilance Bureau, Panchkula, District Panchkula, under Sections 409, 420, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 13(1) (d) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

There is allegation against the present petitioner that he had bought showcase pedestal of *Devdar* wood instead of teak wood whereas

quotations etc. were taken for teak wood. The pedestals were not bought as per the sanction order/quotations and thus, the petitioner had caused a loss of about ₹12 lakhs to the department.

The petitioner has been in custody since 01.06.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
