INDERJIT SINGH, J. (Oral)

This order shall dispose of CRM-M-29728-2018, filed by petitioner-Harjinder Singh and CRM-M-30581-2018, filed by petitioner-Jasbir Singh, under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.117 dated 09.06.2018, registered at Police Station Sohana, District Mohali, under Sections 341, 323, 506, 427, 382, 148 and 149 of IPC and Section 452 IPC added later on.

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Notice of motion was issued in both these petitions. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested these petitions.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

The allegation against the present petitioners is that they had caused simple injuries with blunt weapon and while going from there, they had also snatched away the purse of complainant.

In pursuance of the interim orders dated 18.07.2018 passed in CRM-M-29728-2018 and dated 20.07.2018 passed in CRM-M-30581-2018 by this Court, the petitioners have already joined the investigation. They are not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending them to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in both these petitions and the same are allowed. The orders dated 18.07.2018 passed in CRM-M-29728-2018 and dated 20.07.2018 passed in CRM-M-30581-2018, granting interim bail to the petitioners, are made absolute. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
