Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail pursuant to his bail order having been canceled by trial Court on account of his absence on 12.9.2017.

In view of the fact that the petitioner has approached this Court after almost 10 months and no justification is forthcoming for such long absence, I do not find any ground for grant of anticipatory bail. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed. However, it is directed that in case the petitioner surrenders before the learned trial Court within 10 days from today and applies for grant of regular bail, the learned trial Court shall endeavour to dispose of the same expeditiously, preferably within a period of 3 days thereafter.
