The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest in FIR No.91 dated 24.06.2018 under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 registered at Police Station Chhajli, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 18.07.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Gurmeet Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the

interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 18.07.2018 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
