The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 133 dated 19.09.2016, under Sections 457, 380 IPC, registered at Police Station Ghall Khurd, District Ferozepur.

The operative part of the order dated 19.07.2018, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after registration of the present FIR, the petitioner along with other co-accused was arrested in another FIR No.151 dated 18.10.2016, with similar allegations and he remained in judicial custody for about one and a half month. It is further submitted that aforesaid FIR No.151 was also registered in the same police station and the petitioner was never shown arrested in the present FIR despite the fact that he remained in judicial custody in subsequent FIR. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that co-accused of the petitioner namely Shamsheer Singh @ Samma and another have already been granted the concession of anticipatory bail noticing the aforesaid

facts, vide order dated 11.09.2017 passed in CRM-M-27877-2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 19.07.2018, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Darshan Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 19.07.2018, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
