The instant writ petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to the official respondents to take appropriate action in FIR No.19 dated 17.04.2018, under Sections 323, 376, 377, 498-A of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Women Ballabhgarh.

It is contended that no action has been taken against the culprits after the registration of the aforesaid FIR and in this regard, a representation dated 08.05.2018 (Annexure P-2) has already been moved to the Police Commission, Faridabad. Learned counsel for the petitioner urges that the representation should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At this stage, on the asking of the court Mr. P.P. Chahar, DAG Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits

that official respondents will look into the matter and will decide the representation of the petitioner within a period of four weeks, on receipt of certified copy of this order. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day, failing which no action is called for in the matter.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the representation dated 08.05.2018 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
