The instant writ petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 9 on the representation dated 12.07.2018 to be decided expeditiously.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner herein has been thrown out of her matrimonial home after being subjected to cruelty. In fact the minor son has also been kept back by her husband and in-laws family. It is further contended that she is not getting any support from her parents as well and it is in this background that protection is sought for. It is contended that no legal proceedings have been initiated against respondent Nos. 4 to 9, who are the main persons involved. Learned counsel for the petitioners urges that the representation should be decided

expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At this stage, on the asking of the court Mr. P.P. Chahar, Sr. DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that official respondents will look into the matter and will decide the representation of the petitioners within a period of three months, on receipt of certified copy of this order. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day, failing which no action is called for .

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and also perused the pleadings on record.

In view of the allegations made above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to expeditiously decide the representation dated 12.07.2018 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner and to ensure the welfare of the petitioner herein to provide her necessary protection if deem fit.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
