This is a petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 57 dated 26.5.2018 under Sections 306/34 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Jaito, District Faridkot.

Prosecution case is that Navneet Kaur resident of Goniana Mandiwas married with Hardeep Singh @ Tony and she used to quarrel with her husband. Parties have one son namely Bakshish Singh aged 8 years. It is alleged that present petitioner- Mohinder Singh who is the brother-in-law (*jija*) of Navneet Kaur and her sister Veerpal Kaur used to instigate/helped her. On the date of occurrence, at about 10 AM in the morning when the complainant-Gurminder Kaur went to the house of his son-Hardeep Singh @ Tony, Navneet Kaur was quarreling with her husband-Hardeep Singh. The allegations against the present petitioner- Mohinder Singh are that he used to instigate/help. No suicide note was found. The merits of the case against the present petitioner are yet to be determined during the trial.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the fact that Navneet Kaur and Veerpal Kaur have since been granted bail by this Court.

Therefore, without going into the merits of the case, present petition is allowed and the petitioner-Mohinder Singh, who is in custody since 29.5.2018 is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to any such condition as may be imposed by the trial Court.

Petition is allowed accordingly.
