In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for regular bail under the provision of Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.247 dated 23.09.2017, under Sections 379-A/411 IPC registered at Police Station City Mandi Dabwali.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that co-accused namely Joginder Singh and Naib Singh have been extended benefit of bail on 13.06.2018 and 05.07.2018 respectively. However his bail has been rejected on 10.07.2018. Perusal of the reasoning assigned in the case of Joginder Singh and Naib Singh, it is evident that petitioner who is co-accused, he is also entitled for regular bail.

3. That apart learned State counsel submitted that stolen motorcycle bearing No. HR-25E-4500 has been recovered. Therefore, petitioner's custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

4. Heard the learned counsel for the parties.

5. In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially having regard to the fact that petitioner's custodial interrogation is not required at this stage, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner as no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner.

6. Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner-Shivji Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate. He is also directed to deposit Rs.25,000/- as surety amount in the trial court.

7. However, the petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or other wise interfere with the fair trial.
