Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.57 dated 15.03.2015 under Sections 307, 324, 392, 341, 427, 506, 34 IPC and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Cantonment, District Amritsar City.

While granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, following order was passed on 19.07.2018: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after registration of the FIR, the police is still investigating the case and the matter has been compromised between the petitioner and the injured/victim Sarabjit Singh. It is further submitted that as per allegations in the FIR, no overact is attributed to the petitioner and none of the injury sustained by the complainant Sarabjit Singh was declared as dangerous to life. Counsel for the petitioner has

relied upon the compromise dated 04.06.2018 (Annexure P-2) and affidavit of the complainant of even date i.e. 04.06.2018 (Annexure P-3).

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Sidakmeet Sandhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 while Mr. D.S. Gandhi, Advocate has appeared on behalf of respondent No.2 and they have not disputed the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

List again on 10.10.2018.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Lakhwinder Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 19.07.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
