1. In the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. filed by the petitioner, prayer has been made for issuance of directions to official respondents not to harass and humiliate him and further not to call him in the police station time and again and not to implicate him in any false case at the instance of private respondents No.4 to 7.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, contends that the purpose of the instant petition would be achieved, if respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, is directed to decide representation (Annexure P-2), moved by the petitioner.
3. In view of the above, respondent No. 2-Senior Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, is directed to look into the matter and decide representation (Annexure P-2), moved by the petitioner, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to him, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
4. The instant petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
