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**GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)**

The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 29 dated 23.04.2015 under Sections 420, 406, 120-B of IPC, Police Station No. 6, Jalandhar and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 02.02.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get their statements recorded with regard to genuineness of the compromise.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar has been received wherein it has been reported that statements of the complainant-Ravi Mehta and also of the accused, namely, Surinder

Kapoor, Rajat Kapoor and Vinod Kapoor have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter and that complainant- Ravi Mehta has no objection if the FIR is quashed. It has specifically been opined by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar, that the compromise is genuine and has been effected voluntarily without there being any undue influence or coercion.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 29 dated 23.04.2015 under Sections 420, 406, 120-B of IPC, Police Station No. 6, Jalandhar and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
