Due to typographical error, Manjit Singh was wrongly recorded as respondent No.3 in the order dated 11.01.2018. The error is rectified and Manjit Singh is to be treated as petitioner No.3 in the said order.

On 11.01.2018, following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that Rohi Singh was attributed a danda blow on the person of Baba Charat Singh. As per MLR of Baba Charat Singh, he received three injuries. No injury was found to be covered under Section 307 IPC. Nirbhai Singh was attributed a danda blow on the head of Naib Singh and the same was declared to be simple in nature. Manjit Singh has allegedly used a fire arm,

but no injury was caused to anyone. Similarly Sukhwinder Singh was attributed a gandasi blow at the back of Makhan Singh. As per MLR, the said injury was declared to be simple one having caused with blunt weapon.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Janak Raj submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation, but recovery of fire arm has to be made from the accused/petitioner namely Manjit Singh.

At this juncture, without meaning anything on the merits of the case, the fact regarding joining of investigation by the petitioners in view of order dated 09.08.2017 can be appreciated.

In view of above, the interim order dated 09.08.2017 is made absolute qua petitioners no.1, 2 and 4 namely Rohi Singh, Nirbhai Singh and Sukhwinder Singh. However, Respondent No.3-Manjit Singh is again directed to appear before the Investigating Officer to join investigation on 17.01.2018 and co-operate in the investigation.

Interim order to continue.”

Interim order dated 09.08.2017 was made absolute qua petitioners No.1, 2 and 4. Petitioner No.3 Manjit Singh was again directed to appear before the Investigating Officer to joint investigation and co-operate in the investigation on 17.01.2018.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Harminder Singh states that Manjit Singh has joined the

investigation and recovery has been effected from him. He is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view above, order dated 09.08.2017 is also made absolute qua petitioner No.3/Manjit Singh.

Petition stands disposed of.
