Main case

Petitioner has filed petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking permission to travel abroad for a period of 10 days as mentioned in Annexure P-6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has been granted interim bail by this Court in CRM-M-22776-2018 on 28.05.2018 in case FIR No.29 dated 29.03.2018 under Sections 420/120B IPC, registered at Police Station Cantt., Bathinda and he has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel submits that challan has not been presented in this case.

In view of the averments mentioned in the petition, prayer is allowed. Petitioner is allowed to travel abroad for a period of 06.09.2018 to 14.09.2018, subject to furnishing a bank guarantee amounting to Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs Only) to the satisfaction of the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Bathinda.

On his return, the petitioner shall also furnish his affidavit before the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned within week of his return.
