Petitioner-Rajan has filed this second petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.01 dated 01.01.2017, registered at Police Station Sector 5, Panchkula, under Sections 148, 149, 302 and 324 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that allegation against the petitioner is that he gave kick and fist blows. The injured-complainant and other eye-witness have been examined in the trial Court whose statements

have been placed on record. Both these witnesses have not identified the accused in the Court.

The petitioner has been in custody since 08.01.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody in view of the facts and circumstances of the present case.

In view of the above facts and without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with two sureties in the like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
