The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.0186 dated 30.10.2017, registered under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar.

It has been submitted that 100 kg of *Lahan* has been recovered from the house of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Head Constable Binder Singh, has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation; nothing is to be recovered from him and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 19.07.2018 is made

absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)
Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
