Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.183 dated 12.06.2016 under Section 15 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Jodhewal, District Ludhiana.

Counsel for the petitioner states that in the aforesaid case, the petitioner was on bail, but on 28.05.2018, she could not appear before the trial Court for the reason that her minor daughter was not feeling well. He further states that there is no other case pending against the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. S.P.S. Tinna, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting upon anything on the merits of the case, but considering the fact that the petitioner was earlier on bail in the case and there is no other case pending against her, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within one week from today, she shall be admitted on bail on her furnishing requisite bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court. The trial Court may put any other condition, as it may deem fit in the circumstances of the case.
