The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner-Mamta in case FIR No.412 dated 22.05.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 384, 386, 120B of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Sonapat City, District Sonapat.

Heard.

The allegation against the petitioner in the FIR is that she duped the complainant-Karan Singh. She blackmailed him and had extorted money by extending threats to implicate him in some false cases. On 13.11.2017, Karan Singh entered her house and outraged her modesty.

Instant FIR is registered against her on 22.05.2018 on the allegation that Karan Singh is retired Government official and they have duped him of huge amount of money for securing job. The petitioner has joined investigation, nothing is to be recovered from her.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the order dated 19.07.2018 is made absolute till the presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall make herself available for interrogation by the police as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against her so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioner will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
- (v) that in case she requires in investigation, then investigation be conducted by lady officer not below the rank of Sub-Inspector.
