The petitioner-Vicky son of Shri Khushi Ram, seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.40, dated 23.02.2018, registered at Police Station Israna, Panipat, under sections 379-A read with section 34 IPC.

As per the allegation in the FIR, three young people wearing blue and black clothes snatched the Motorcycle of the complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not specifically named and that he has been falsely implicated in the present FIR. There is no other criminal case pending against him. Moreover, investigation is complete and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in custody indefinitely as the trial will not be concluded at an early date.

Learned State counsel submits that the incidents of snatching are on the rise and therefore, persons accused of the said offence should not be given any

leniency.

Keeping in view the fact that there is no other criminal case pending against the petitioner as also that the investigation is complete and that the trial may not be concluded at an early date, I deem it just and appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner.

Thus, the petition is allowed and the petitioner-Vicky son of Shri Khushi Ram, is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court concerned at Panipat.
