Ms. Rajni Maurya, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of complainant No.2 and has filed memorandum of appearance which is taken on record.

The petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.160 dated 22.05.2018 under Sections 279, 337, 338, 427 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Division No.5, District Ludhiana and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 19.07.2018 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.

Report of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana has been received wherein it has been reported that statements of the petitioner/accused as well as of complainant-Sukhdev Singh have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter and that complainant has no objection if the FIR in question is quashed. It has specifically been opined by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana that the compromise is genuine and has been effected voluntarily without there being any undue influence or coercion.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.160 dated 22.05.2018 under Sections 279, 337, 338, 427 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Division No.5, District Ludhiana and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
