ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. :

The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.161 dated 02.05.2018 under Sections 420/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala.

The operative part of the order dated 20.07.2018 vide which bail was granted to the petitioner, reads as under:-

“Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that after registration of the FIR, he has settled the dispute with the complainant and has repaid the entire amount as per the allegation in the FIR and the complainant has also furnished an affidavit (Annexure P3).

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and the challan has also been submitted before the trial Court.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 20.07.2018 is made absolute.
