Petitioner No.1 Rekha states that she is residing separately from her mother and other brothers and sisters. Her younger brothers and sisters, namely, Neeraj, Kumkum, Raveena and Mukesh are residing with her mother-Manju who is looking after them. Manju-respondent No.6 is present in the Court. She states that she is taking care of her minor children, though petitioner No.1 Rekha is residing separately.

Learned State counsel has informed that challan has since been filed against Ram Bilas on 30.10.2017. Now, the case is fixed for prosecution evidence. The present petition was filed for issuance of order/direction to State of Punjab to protect life and liberty of the petitioners. Since in view of the latest situation, no such threat exists as petitioner No.1 Rekha is residing separately from her mother, whereas Manju is taking care of her minor children.

This petition cannot survive and is dismissed accordingly.
