The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.384 dated 24.06.2017, registered under Sections 120-B, 420, 467, 468, 471, 494 and 497 IPC at Police Station City Sonapat, District Sonapat.

Notice of motion was issued on 11.08.2017. Thereafter, on 02.11.2017, the petitioner was allowed to join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in

terms of order dated 02.11.2017, petitioner has already joined the investigation and has been released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.
