The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing SC/86/7.10.2017 under Sections 27(B) II & C of Drugs & Cosmetic Act, 1940 titled as State Vs. Sandeep Singh pending in the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Barnala dated 27.01.2015 against the impugned order dated 11.7.2018 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Barnala, forfeiting the bail bonds and surety bonds and issuing non bailable warrants and surety for 02.08.2018.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that vide the impugned order dated 11.07.2018, the bail bonds of the petitioners have been cancelled, although an application for exemption was filed. Counsel further submits that petitioners have been regularly attending the Court proceedings. There is no other default.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. K.S. Aulakh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. The impugned order is quashed. It is directed that the petitioners shall surrender before the trial Court on or before 02.08.2018. In case the petitioners surrenders before the trial Court as mentioned above, then the petitioners shall be released on bail by the trial Court on their furnishing fresh bail bonds/ sureties to the satisfaction of the trial Court. However, if the petitioners do not surrender as aforesaid, then the petitioners shall not be entitled to any benefit under the present order.
