Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0068 dated 14.03.2018, registered under Sections 420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code read with Section 13 of Punjab Human Trafficking Act at Police Station City Rajpura, District Patiala.

Learned State counsel submitted that although the petitioner has joined the investigation but he failed to submit the copy of compromise and that has been supplied today which is taken into the possession by ASI Jaspal Singh, Police Station City Rajpura.

As per the compromise, the petitioner had paid Rs.5,00,000/- and for remaining amount he has already issued a cheque as a security and this amount shall be paid at the time of quashment. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has already filed a petition for quashing of the FIR.

In this view of the matter, the interim order dated 05.09.2018, passed by this court, is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and also the petitioner shall not leave the country without the prior permission of the trial court.

Petition stands allowed.
