The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.15 dated 12.01.2018, registered under Sections 147, 149, 323, 427, 452 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Badhra, District Charkhi Dadri.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioner has joined the proceedings and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 24.01.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
