GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)

By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against them vide FIR No.0241 dated 17.10.2017 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Division No.5, Ludhiana.

The allegations, in nutshell, are that the petitioners, who are infact related to the complainant, had prepared a forged WILL of late Sh. Rakesh Kumar Verma, who was father of complainant and also of petitioners No.1 and 2 and husband of petitioner No.3.

Pursuant to interim directions issued by this Court on the last date, the petitioners have already joined investigation, as has been informed by learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Malkit Ram, who is present in Court. ASI Malkit Ram has also informed that infact the matter has been compromised amongst the parties.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and bearing in mind the fact that the present case is mainly based on

documentary evidence and that the petitioners have already joined investigation, in my opinion, it is a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners. The present petition, as such, is accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 19.7.2018 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioners shall appear before the Investigating Officer as and when directed.

The present petition stands accepted accordingly.
