Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no fair investigation whatsoever has been carried out by the police even after FIR no.115 dated 12.09.2017 was registered at Police Station Julkan, District Patiala, alleging therein commission of offences punishable under Sections 302, 323, 148 and 149 IPC.

In respect of his grievance, the petitioner is stated to have made a representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala (respondent no.2) on 23.03.2017, a copy of which has been annexed as Annexure P-3 with the petition, on which again no action is stated to have been taken so far.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the

Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala (respondent no.2) to go into the grievance of the petitioner and to take action as per law, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

It is however made clear that this Court has not made any comment whatsoever on the contents of the writ petition or the representation made to the Senior Superintendent of Police.
