The learned State counsel has informed that despite directions issued by this Court, the petitioner has not joined investigation.

It may here be mentioned that initially it was on 10.8.2018 that this Court, while granting interim bail, had directed the petitioner to join investigation. However, on the next date i.e. on 23.10.2018, it had been informed by the learned State counsel that the petitioner did not come forward to join investigation and consequently this Court again directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer to join the investigation on 13.11.2018.

Today again the learned State counsel has informed that the petitioner has not come forward to join investigation.

In view of the aforesaid position, the petitioner does not deserve the concession of anticipatory bail.

The petition, as such, is dismissed.
