SUDIP AHLUWALIA J. (ORAL)

In this petition, the petitioners, who are the accused persons in DDR No.34 dated 18.11.2016 in F.I.R No.183, dated 18.11.2016, under Sections 323, 324, 307, 341 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Doraha, Khanna, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-1), have prayed for quashing of F.I.R. with all subsequent proceedings, on the basis of compromise.

[2]. With the intervention of respectables and elderly people of the society, the complainants have arrived at a settlement with the accused vide Compromise (Annexure P-3), which is duly signed by them. The matter was referred to the Court below for recording of statements of the parties and to report with respect to genuineness of the compromise arrived at between the parties. The Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Payal, vide report dated

06.12.2017, has apprised this Court that the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine and without any pressure.

[3]. Respondent Nos.2 and 3 are represented by their Counsel and do not oppose the compromise.

[4]. In view of the report of the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Payal, and in view of the decisions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in "**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**", 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and "**Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another**", (2014) 6 SCC 466, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose can be served by keeping with the criminal proceedings pending, since the complainants have themselves compromised the dispute with the petitioners/accused persons.

[5]. In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed. DDR No.34 dated 18.11.2016 in F.I.R No.183, dated 18.11.2016, under Sections 323, 324, 307, 341 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Doraha, Khanna, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-1), and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.
