Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to take action on the complaint submitted by petitioner No.1 and 3, to respondent No.2 as it has disclosed commission of cognizable offences.

Reply by way of affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police (Central) Ludhiana, has been filed and as per para 3 of the reply, in the enquiry conducted by ADCP-1, Ludhiana, it is found that the sale deeds are genuine documents, having been executed by petitioners No.1 and 2 in favour of the private respondents and the same are not the forged documents.

In view of the same, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw this petition with liberty to avail alternative remedy before the Competent Court, for redressal of his grievance.
