The petitioners pray for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect their life, liberty and property, which is allegedly being threatened by respondents No. 4 to 8.

The case of the petitioners is that the petitioners have invested a sum of Rs. 28 lacs in a project floated by respondents No. 4 to 8. Neither the project has been completed nor the money has been returned. A representation dated 02.07.2018 (Annexure P-7) has been submitted to the police authorities but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3. Let four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notices to the private respondents.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 2

to objectively consider the representation dated 02.07.2018 (Annexure P-7) and

in case it is found that the life, liberty and property of the petitioners is being threatened, suitable action be taken in accordance with law. The exercise be completed within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
