The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.406 dated 31.07.2017 registered under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468, 471, 201 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sadar Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 04.10.2017 and the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has already been submitted by the police in the Court of competent jurisdiction on 18.12.2017. It is further contended that the charges are yet to be framed and no recovery is to be effected from the petitioner.

On instructions from ASI Jitender, learned State counsel has duly acknowledged the above factual position.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the

paper book.

In view of the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 04.10.2017 and the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been submitted and charges are yet to be framed and the case is to be tried by a Magistrate's Court. The trial is likely to take a long time to be concluded and as such no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars any more. Therefore, in view of the abovesaid circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is accepted. Petitioner-Sonia be admitted to bail on her furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
