The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to fairly investigate the FIR No.159 dated 15.06.2018 under Sections 323, 341 and 506 IPC registered at Police Station Sarangpur, U.T., Chandigarh.

Admittedly, the aforesaid FIR was registered on 15.06.2018 and it can safely be presumed that the police must be investigating the case. Therefore, prayer of the petitioner cannot be accepted at this stage, as it would tantamount to interfere in the case, which is otherwise being investigated by the police.

Therefore, this Court does not find any merit in the present petition as the same has been filed at pre-matured stage.

The petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
