1. Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.02 dated 18.06.2018 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 341/427/323/ 382 IPC and 25/54/59 of Arms Act, at Police Station Ranjit Avenue, District Amritsar and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom in terms of compromise (Annexure P-2).

2. Pursuant to order dated 01.08.2018 parties appeared before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 04.09.2018 to get their statements recorded. Learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar has submitted his report vide letter bearing No.303 dated 12.09.2018 duly forwarded by District & Sessions Judge, Amritsar vide Endst. No. 9060 R dated 15.09.2018.

3. According to the report, learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar is satisfied that compromise entered into between the parties is genuine, voluntary and without any sort of pressure, threat or coercion from any corner.

4. In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony and peace in relations between the parties, this petition is allowed and the aforesaid, FIR No.02 dated 18.06.2018 (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, qua the petitioner are quashed, subject to payment of costs of Rs.10,000/-, out of which Rs. 4,000/- shall be deposited with the Bar Association, Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh; Rs. 1,000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana and Rs.5,000/- with the High Court Legal Services Authority, within a period of two weeks' from today, failing which this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.
