The present petition filed under Section 482 Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

Learned State counsel has placed on record copy of the statement of petitioner No.1-Neelam Rani in which she has stated that they do not apprehend any threat from the hands of private respondents therefore, they do not require any police protection.

In this view of the matter, the present petition has rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.

However, in case any of the petitioners apprehend any threat to their limb, life and liberty in future, they may approach to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tehsil and District Patiala and in that eventuality, be provided protection as prayed for.
