The petitioner alleges that complaints were made against him by respondent Nos.6 and 7 when he was employed on election duty. The said complaints were found to be false by the State Election Commission and the case was directed to be filed. Thereafter, the petitioner approached respondent No.2 citing the report of the State Election Commission and prayed that legal action be taken against respondent Nos.6 and 7. An enquiry was conducted thereupon and a finding was returned in favour of the petitioner. The said report has been misplaced by HC-Surinder Pal Singh and therefore, a DDR has been recorded on the complaint of the petitioner. Thereafter, the petitioner has moved a representation dated 19.12.2017 (Annexure P9) before respondent No.2 with a request that the misplaced report be traced. The said representation has been marked to respondent No.3 and as yet, the same is pending consideration.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to dispose of representation dated 19.12.2017 (Annexure P9) within a time bound manner.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3 to examine representation dated 19.12.2017 (Annexure P9) and decide the same by passing a speaking order, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
