Prayer in this application filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is to place on record documents Annexures P-5 to P-8 to substantiate the date of birth of petitioners.

For the reasons stated in the application, same is allowed and the documents Annexures P-5 to P-8 are taken on record.

CRM-M-30514-2018

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents i.e. respondents No.4 to 6.

It has been contended in the petition that the petitioners are major and have solemnized their marriage in accordance with law. However, respondents No.4 to 6 are not accepting their marriage and are adamant to separate them from each other by resorting to illegal means. It

liberty of the petitioners, petitioner No.1-Sakshi Sharma had moved a representation dated 18.07.2018 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.2 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Notice of motion only to respondents No.1 to 3 at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Tanvir Joshi, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Keeping in view the limited prayer made in the petition and without going into the validity of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take appropriate remedial measures, as warranted by law, on the representation dated 18.07.2018 (Annexure P-4) submitted by petitioner No.1.

In the meantime, necessary order be passed to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.
