The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.170 dated 26.02.2018 registered under Sections 21/61/85/27A of NDPS Act at Police Station City Sirsa.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that no recovery has been effected from the petitioner. The recovery has been effected from the co-accused of the petitioner. The alleged recovery is only 9 grams of heroin which is a non-commercial quantity. It is further contended that even the co-accused from whom the recovery was effected, has been granted bail pending trial. It is also contended that the petitioner is in custody since 02.05.2018.

On the other hand, counsel for the State has submitted that there are other cases against the petitioner, including the cases under NDPS

In response to this, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is on bail in all those cases except the present one.

In view of the above submissions, but without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail pending trial on his furnishing bail bonds/ sureties to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate.
