Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.91 dated 29.06.2018 under Sections 393/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Nathusari Chopta, District Sirsa.

As per FIR, allegations against the petitioner are that on 29.06.2018 at about 11.15 PM during night, when the complainant after closing his shop was taking meal, an Alto car bearing registration No.HR-24Q-2270 came there and three young boys namely Mange Ram Beniwal, Vikram @ Tarzen (petitioner) and the third boy who was not known to the complainant entered the liquor vend. The petitioner took away a beer bottle and after breaking the same started opening the cash box of the shop. However, the moment Ram Kumar (Contractor) reached near the liquor

vend, all three boys tried to run away in their car. The driver of the car was

apprehended and two boys including the petitioner succeeded in escaping.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case and no recovery is required to be effected from him and he is ready to join the investigation.

On the other hand, learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Subhash Chander, states that the petitioner is involved in as many as 09 other cases and there are specific allegations against the petitioner whose identification is not in dispute.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the nature of allegations, coupled with the fact that there are other cases against the petitioner more or less of a similar nature, no ground to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.
