In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for anticipatory bail under the provision of Section 438 Cr.P.C in FIR No.72 dated 23.04.2018 registered under Sections 323, 324, 325, 326, 114, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station Ismailabad, District Kurukshetra.

2. Petitioner had approached Sessions Court seeking same relief of anticipatory bail and it has been rejected on 9.7.2018. Hence, the present petition.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner vehemently submitted that no specific averment has been made in the FIR insofar as causing injury by him and so also having regard to the nature of injury is with blunt weapon, petitioner is entitled to anticipatory bail.

4. Perusal of the records, it is evident that petitioner has caused two injuries on the person of Kuldeep Singh by an iron rod and Doctor has found fracture in injury No.2 sustained by injured Kuldeep Singh, which is attributed to accused petitioner-Amandeep Singh. Having regard to the grievous injury, petitioner is not entitled to anticipatory bail as sought in the present petition.

5. Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
