**AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)**

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been declared a proclaimed offender by order dated 29.04.2015 (Annexure P-8) in the cross version in FIR No.132 dated 06.08.2013, Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib. He contends that the petitioner had gone abroad and the order does reflect that, however, then also the petitioner has been declared a proclaimed offender.

Counsel contends that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the trial proceedings and for this purpose, he would appear before the trial Court on **01.02.2018** and submit to the jurisdiction of the Court.

In case the petitioner appears before the trial Court on 01.02.2018 and moves an application for grant of regular bail, his application shall be entertained and his bail/surety bonds shall be accepted to the satisfaction of the Court with regard to his presence. The petitioner to move an application for grant of regular bail, which shall be considered and decided by the Court expeditiously and preferably within a period of three days. Till the decision of the application, in case the petitioner surrenders, he shall be admitted to interim bail.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
