Vide order dated 4.5.2017 passed in CRM-M No. 15413 of 2017, petitioner was allowed to withdraw the petition with a liberty to surrender before the trial Court and file petition for regular bail. In the event of doing so, petition was to be decided on the same day in accordance with law.

It appears that instead of complying with the aforesaid order, the second petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been filed.

In view of the order earlier passed on 4.5.2017 in CRM-M No. 15413 of 2017, no indulgence in terms of Section 438 Cr.P.C. can be granted.
